We do not sell items, we only display them.

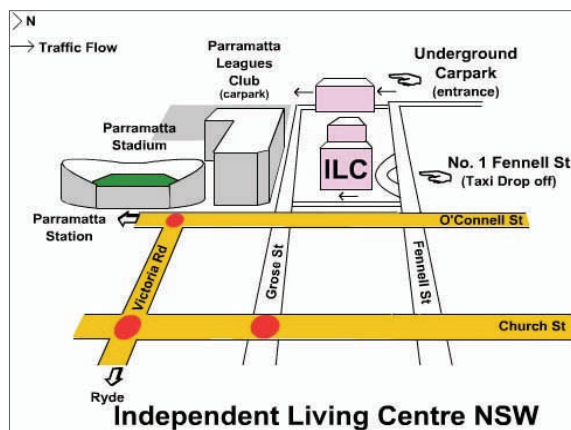
