- fixtures and fittings

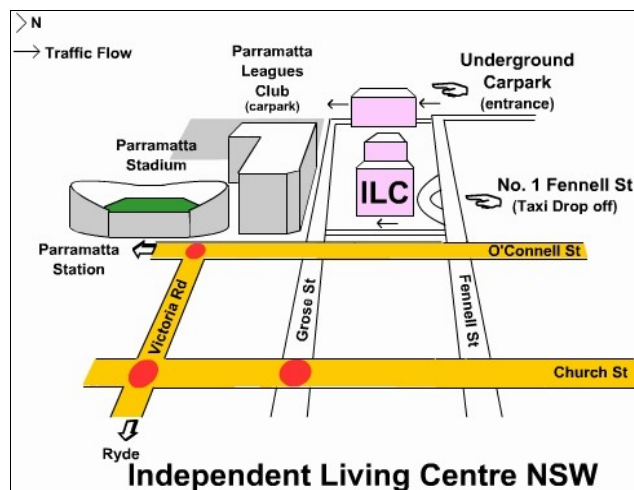
