Advanced Features

Signing up to an @magic account is FREE!

By signing up you will be given full access to advanced features.

Advanced features allow you to access functions including clipboard save, products compare, AT recommendation, and educational modules anytime.



Faceted Search

Faceted search allows you to progressively refine your search results in real-time. Multiple filters can be applied to the search results in any order to narrow down the results until the desired items are found. **You do not need to sign up to use this feature.**



Creating a Clipboard

A clipboard is a place where you can shortlist and save products that interest you. Clipboards also allow you to add and save notes about a product.



Compare Products

Comparing products will help you more easily decide which products are more suitable. To compare items, click the 'Compare Products' button. This allows you to do a side-by-side comparison of products. You will need to 'drag-and-drop' the items from the top area into the compare area.



Assistive Technology Recommendations

AT Recommendation is a print-friendly version of your clipboard items. You can create AT recommendations, keep for your own records, or attach with equipment request funding forms. When you create an AT recommendation, you are given the option of selecting product supplier details, editing the information included, adding comments and recommending suitable models and options.



Assistive Technology Supplier Demonstrations

AT Australia film suppliers demonstrating their products and explore the product features. These are called AT Demonstrations on the website. A supplier demonstration is an opportunity for users to view a piece of assistive technology as seen through the eyes of the AT Australia staff.



Educational Modules

These are an introduction to an area of assistive technology with a focus on available models, options and features as well as essential considerations. Educational modules combine slides, audio commentary and video demonstrations. Designed for those new to assistive technology.



Therapeutic Discussion

A Therapeutic Discussion is an informal discussion between therapists based around a case study. Therapeutic discussions are presented as a podcast (audio) enhanced with photographs.
